Marcia Pally has lectured widely at universities and professional associations, among them Harvard, Columbia, The University of Chicago, Humboldt University (Berlin), The University of Zurich, The Cato Institute, and the Aspen Institute-Berlin. She is past vice president of The *Freedom to Read Foundation*.
